9:45-12:45 Coach and Stroll Tour (3 hr. tour including the State House, Historic District and Naval Academy) *a guide will board our bus for this tour.

1PM – 2:45 Lunch on your own/free time.

2:45PM Meet at the dock to board Harbor Queen riverboat; ride begins at 3PM.
(40 minute narrated cruise)

4PM – 7PM Supper on your own/free time.

***This trip is handicap accessible. Even though we will be getting off the bus at both the State House and Naval Academy, there are options available for those not able to walk long distances. It is only a short walk to the harbor for the cruise.*

The Maryland State House is the oldest state capital in continuous legislative use, dating to 1772. The **United States Naval Academy** is a four-year academy, established on October 10, 1845. It is the second oldest of the United States' five service academies, and educates officers for commissioning primarily into the US Navy and US Marines.
